



IASF to Launch New 100-Point Score Sheet for the global All Star market and the 2027 Cheerleading World Championships

The International All Star Foundation (IASF) is moving forward with a new score sheet initiative, designed to better support athletes, coaches, and event producers worldwide. The updated score sheet and scoring resources will be introduced across the international all star market and is slated to be used at the **2027 Cheerleading World Championships** for all IASF divisions.

This update reflects ongoing work to create clear, practical systems that help athletes, coaches, event producers, and officials operate within a shared framework—no matter where they are in the world.

The new score sheet will transition to a **100-point scale**, while retaining the established weighting framework that reflects long-standing sport governance models. This ensures that all star cheerleading maintains its distinct identity, even as it evolves alongside other emerging global sports.

Why This Change

The transition to a 100-point system is a deliberate and strategic step forward, designed to better reflect how the sport is evolving and how it is experienced globally.

Key considerations:

- **Global Clarity & Accessibility**
A 100-point scale provides a universally recognized framework, improving comprehension for athletes, coaches, audiences, and emerging markets around the world.
- **Better alignment with International Sport Systems**
The shift reflects the evolving all star market, creating a more seamless experience for teams participating across both all star and international cheer pathways that utilize the 100 point scales.
- **Flexibility across markets**
The score sheet continues to support a range of competitive strategies, making it accessible for both developing and highly competitive all star markets. The revised score sheet will maintain the core principles of the IASF comparative framework, continuing to support strategic choice and allowing teams to construct routines that highlight their unique strengths.



- **Improved understanding of comparative scoring**

Additional resources will help *coaches and athletes* better understand how scores are applied within the context of their level and division.

Key Milestones

- **Mid-April 2026** — *Official Score Sheet Release*
- **July 2026** — *Release of benchmarking guide and educational materials*

This evolution represents a meaningful step in aligning the global All Star community under a shared, accessible, and forward-looking scoring framework. The IASF remains steadfast in its support of international sport development—committed to fostering clarity, fairness, and opportunity for athletes and stakeholders around the world.
